

## HYGIENE RULES FOR SPECTATORS OF THE EHF FINAL4 2021

### Information on admission to the LANXESS arena:

- Due to the personalised tickets, admission is only possible upon presentation of your **printed DIN A4 ticket** and your identity card/passport.
- Admission to the LANXESS arena is only possible upon **presentation of a valid negative Corona rapid test. Only test results carried out in Germany will be accepted.** The quick test must be carried out on Saturday, 12.06.2021.
- The EHF FINAL4 2021 testing requirement also applies to fully vaccinated and recovered persons.
- By scanning the ticket on the day of the event, each spectator confirms the following points on a daily basis:
  1. according to the currently valid regulations, I have not been in any foreign high incidence or virus variant area according to the classification of the RKI.
  2. I have not knowingly had any contact with an infected person within the last 14 days and am not subject to any officially ordered or medically advised segregation, quarantine or isolation.
  3. I do not currently have any symptoms of an acute respiratory illness (according to the RKI) or unclear symptoms of an acute illness.
- Admission & bag regulations: Bags are only allowed up to DIN A4. If possible, please refrain from bringing bags.

### Rules of conduct in the LANXESS arena

- An FFP2 mask must be worn throughout the event area. Admission will only be granted with an FFP2 mask on. In the LANXESS arena only the FFP2 masks are to be worn which you will receive with your ticket on site.
- Not permitted are: FFP2 or FFP3 masks with valve, surgical masks, everyday masks, self-sewn masks, scarves, neckerchiefs or pre-hung textiles.
- Inside and outside the LANXESS arena, both in the square and on the entire event site, the minimum distance of 1.5m from other groups of people must be observed. Please also pay attention to the minimum distance already when making your way to the event. The distance must be observed both on arrival, when approaching the LANXESS arena and when leaving the grounds and on the way home.
- The LANXESS arena is divided into different zones. Please use the access printed on your ticket.
- Adhere to the seating and spacing markings at all times and avoid queuing.
- The serving of alcohol is prohibited throughout the running of the event.
- After entering the LANXESS arena, proceed directly to your seat and avoid all unnecessary walking routes (exception: direct route to the sanitary facilities and back to the assigned seat). Stay at your designated seat before and during the match.
- Pay attention to hand hygiene, use the hand disinfectant available in the LANXESS arena and avoid grabbing your face or touching handles, railings or similar. Also adhere to the cough & sneeze etiquette.

- Follow the instructions of the security, the announcements, the signs on site and the information on the display boards at all times. Failure to comply with hygiene rules or security instructions will result in an arena ejection (no refund).
- In the event that you feel ill or have symptoms suggestive of Covid-19 illness, it is imperative that you remain at home. The protection of all spectators, athletes and staff is our top priority. As a precaution, we must deny you access or send you home during the event should you have Covid-19 symptoms (e.g. fever, cough, cold, sore throat, general weakness, diarrhoea, smell or taste disorder).
